EVENLEY VILLAGE HALL ACCESS STATEMENT

Evenley Village Halls is at the heart of our community and Evenley Village Hall Management Committee (EVHMC) believe it should reach out and be accessible to all members of our community, ensuring everyone can make full use of the building and its facilities

The first paragraph of Evenley Village Hall Management Committee's Mission Statement says *EVHMC aim to provide a first class, safe, accessible, well maintained and well-presented village hall, to be used for social, recreational, educational and leisure activities with facilities which will be to the benefit of and meet the needs and desires of Evenley residents and hall's users.*

A disability access audit was undertaken in 2003 and repeated in 2017, with the assistance of two disabled people.

The village hall can easily be reached by car, taxi and public transport. Access to the building is via level surfaces, without steps or inclines and has wheelchair access. There is a dedicated area for disabled parking.

Internally, all doors are sufficiently wide to accommodate wheelchairs. All surfaces are none slip. There is a disabled unisex toilet.

Where appropriate, signs include both words and pictures to aid understanding. Consideration has been given with décor, to aid the partially sighted.

The Kitchen has access for those in wheelchairs, but the kitchen has not been designed for disabled hall users. There is no induction hearing loop fitted to the main hall.

EVHMC are committed to continually improve disability access to all areas of the hall.
